As used in this document:

CPL: Concealed Pistol License

FFL: Federal Firearms Licensee (gun shop/dealer)

LTP: License to Purchase

NFA: National Firearms Act (Federal restrictions on certain firearms

including "machine guns" and others)

NICS: National Instant Criminal Background Check System (used by firearms dealers and law enforcement agencies)

RI-010: Form provided by local law enforcement agencies, aka a License to Purchase (LTP)

RI-060: Form provided by the Michigan State Police for documenting firearms transactions
